

Why are we asking patients for their driver's license or a government issued photo id?

The Endocrinology Clinic of Minneapolis has an Identity Theft Prevention Program to safeguard our patients.

The purpose is to identify possible risks of identity theft; detect suspicious documents, or suspicious changes of personal identification, or any other unusual or suspicious activity that may occur with a patient account.

One of the ways that we do this is by obtaining identifying information (such as a Driver's License) and verifying the information we have matches the patient; i.e. verifying that it matches the information we have in the computer and matches the insurance card and credit card that is presented.

The Driver's license will be scanned, just like your insurance card. We will only ask for this identification once.
